Two of the others who perished in this accident were Joseph Smith, also buried in Westbourne churchyard (no. NEB 138) and the Revd. Herbert Morse, curate of St. James's, Emsworth, who is buried in Warblington churchyard (no. SE 623 of the Warblington record). Morse was commemorated also by a tablet in St. James's Church, which gives a fuller account of the tragedy.
